Pursuant to notice through the media and in conformance with the Public Meeting Law, Darin J. Fowler, Chair, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Items discussed were as follows:

- 1. LAND USE HEARING:** *(Hearings are conducted in accordance with Josephine County Land Use Hearing Rules as they apply to Remand Hearings, a copy of which is available from the Recorder.)*

Continued appeal to the Board of County Commissioners of the Community Development Director's decision to approve a Conditional Use Permit for the placement of a Private Recreational Vehicle (RV) Campground in the Exclusive Farm (EF) zone. The proposed development includes 25 RV spaces with water and electric to sites and a centralized wastewater dump station for temporary overnight use located at 7346 New Hope Road; Josephine County Assessor's records as Map: 37-06-24, Tax Lot (TL) 301. The property owner is Majestic Destinations/Marquess & Associates – Jim Higday. (Continued from March 16, 2020)

Commissioner Fowler explained due to the Governor's stay-at-home order, the Board has decided to postpone this hearing until May 18, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. in the Anne Basker Auditorium. The 150-day timeline expires on June 24, 2020.

Commissioner Morgan made a motion to continue the hearing until May 18, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. in the Anne Basker Auditorium, seconded by Commissioner Fowler. Upon roll call vote, motion passed 2-0; Commissioner Morgan – yes and Commissioner Fowler – yes.
