ALL GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS APPLY

1. Exhibit set-up time shall be from 9 a.m., Sunday, August 16 through 7 p.m. Monday, August 17. All exhibits must be ready for judging by 7 p.m. Monday, August 17. Removal time shall be from 9 a.m. until noon Sunday, August 23.
2. Each exhibit must emphasize one of three areas of Grange work - Agriculture, Community Service or Legislative Activities.
3. At least one (1) Grange emblem, a minimum of 6 inches tall, must be clearly displayed on each exhibit.
4. Exhibits should have a theme, which is clearly identified. It is not mandatory, but suggested to follow the theme of the Fair.
5. It is suggested that each Grange use three (3) 8 foot tables on which to set their exhibit up. Granges using tables must have attractive skirting for their exhibit, as well.
6. No alcohol products or scenes depicting the use of alcohol products will be allowed.
7. No offensive material (manure, spoiled or unsightly produce, etc.) shall be used in the exhibit.
8. No exhibit shall depict any idea or concept contrary to Grange beliefs, policy or principles.
9. Exhibits must score a minimum average of fifty (50) points from the Booth examiners to qualify for cash awards. A copy of the tabulated results for each Grange will be sent to each Grange Secretary.
- 10 Exhibits will be examined by one judge from each Grange. Exhibits will be examined to determine if they meet the minimum requirements only. No place scores will be given. Exhibits will be examined for content as follows:

- A. **Visualization of Message** - does the exhibit have a special message for the viewer? Does exhibit give the viewer a better understanding and appreciation of the area represented? 40 Points
- B. **Artistry and Neatness** - center of interest, balance, simplicity, color, effective use of materials and plant products. 30 Points
- C. **Originality** - is basic concept of the exhibit original? 30 Points

11. All qualifying exhibits shall be awarded a premium. Ribbons will be awarded on a graduated basis from 1st thru last place, based on the People's Choice Award Judging.
