The Josephine County sheriff's office is pleased to provide Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST) Firearms Qualification Course to retired Law Enforcement Officers pursuant to the Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act for a fee.

Retired Law Enforcement Officers wishing to complete the DPSST Firearms Qualification Course can contact the Sheriff's Civil Division in the Justice Building located at 601 N.W. 5<sup>th</sup> Street, to reserve a spot in the course no later than **April 15, 2008**. The next qualification date is April 16, 2008. Each participant will be required to provide 50 rounds of factory fresh ammunition for their handgun. **No Reloads** will be allowed at the range.

April 16 from 1430 hours until 1730 hours, there will be a retired law enforcement, HR 218 shoot at the Law Enforcement range at the Josephine County Sportsman's Park.

The Fee for the PQC is \$40.00, payable to the Josephine County Sheriff's office by the April 15, 2008 deadline. If the participant is not a member of the Josephine County Sportsman's Association, you will need to pay the day use fee for the range.

Fees include:

DPSST target

Range Training Officer conducting the Qualification

Qualification Card- Valid for one year from the qualification date

Retired Officers are limited to 2 qualification attempts per day. If a retiree does not qualify after two attempts, they will have to wait for the next qualification day and pay the qualification fee again.
