Chair Simon G. Hare called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

**1. Order No. 2017-004; In the Matter of Notice of Closure of Sand Creek Bridge on Sand Creek Road over Sand Creek ORS 192.640(3) (One original Order filed with the County Clerk)**

The Board called for an emergency closure of Sand Creek Road due to a bridge blown out and a detour is in place. Rob Brandes, Public Works Director, submitted Sand Creek Road Bridge Closure Detour (**Exhibit 1**).

Commissioner DeYoung made a motion to approve Order No. 2017-004; In the Matter of Notice of Closure of Sand Creek Bridge on Sand Creek Road over Sand Creek, seconded by Commissioner Morgan. Upon roll call vote, motion passed 3-0; Commissioner DeYoung – yes, Commissioner Morgan – yes and Commissioner Hare – yes.

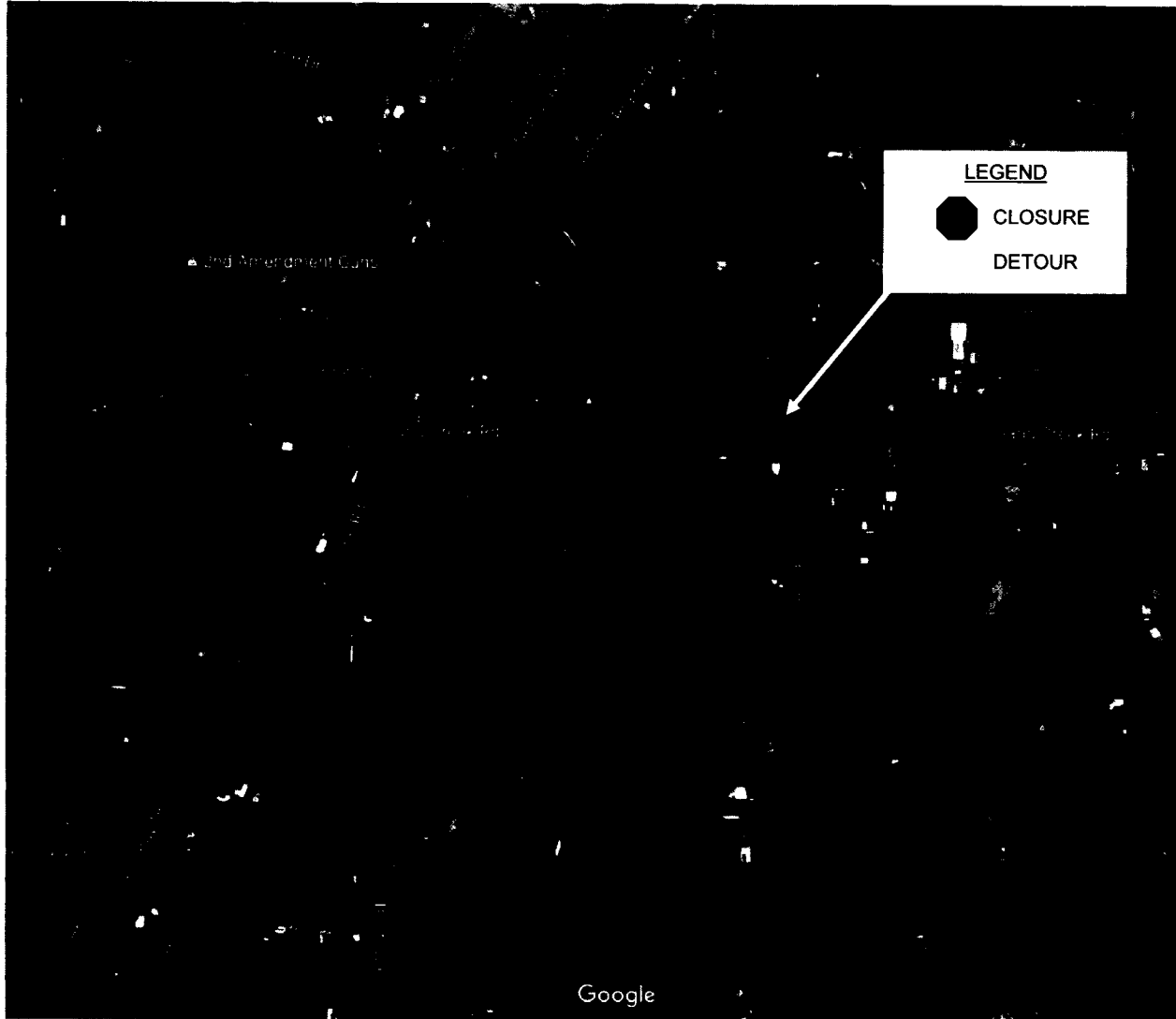

The meeting adjourned at 3:05 p.m.

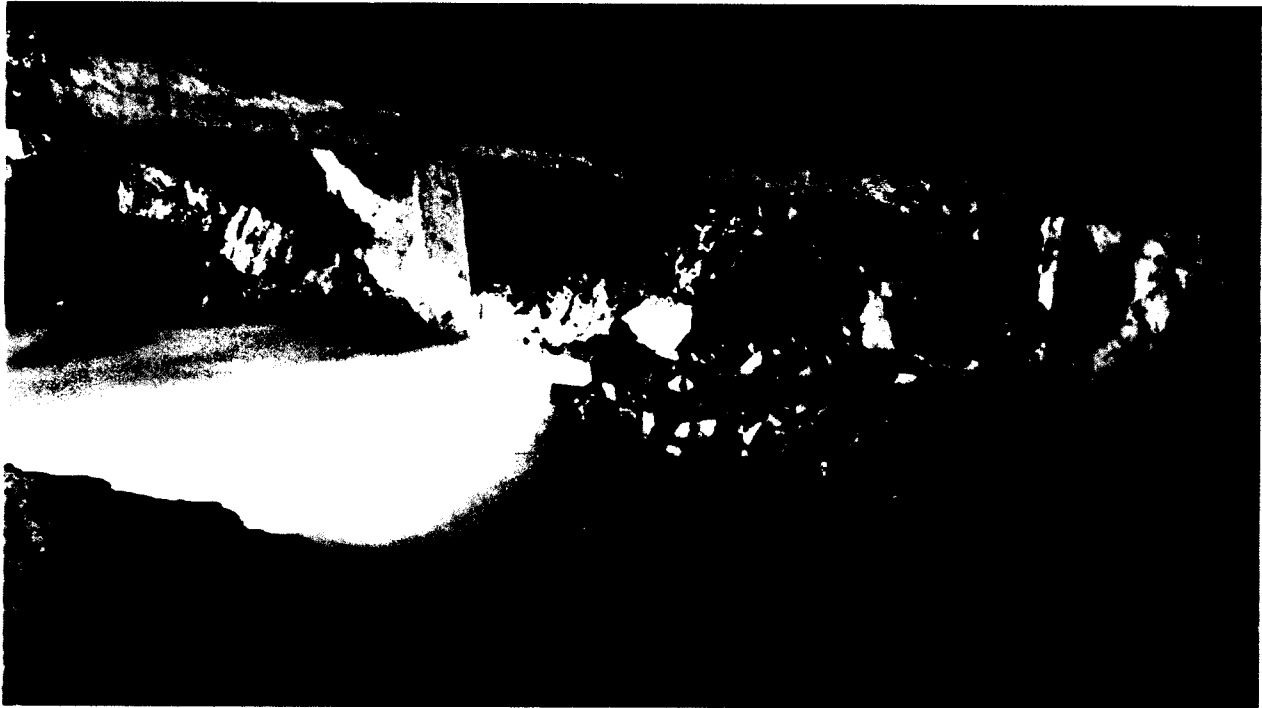

## Sand Creek Road Bridge Closure Detour

Sand Creek Road over Sand Creek (Bridge 374005) has experienced significant scour from the recent large rain event which also resulted in the failure of the GPID canal (Sand Creek). Currently Josephine County Public Works is working with OBEC Engineers to develop a repair. At this time Public Works is concerned for the stability of the bridge and adjacent roadway and is requesting formal direction from the Board of County Commissioners to close the road until such time as the safety of the public can be assured.
